
Unit 5 Activity: Develop a Page for a Business

Use an eyedropper tool to get this color from the design image.

This looks like "Bilbo Swish Caps" from Google fonts. Use that and whatever sans-serif font looks good for the rest.

Consider a line break to split this up, or changing the font sizes before/after the phone icon. Everything else on this page is well-centered, so this line sticks out in a bad way.

There's something weird about the heart icon, and she doesn't like the smiley, so let's not even try to extract these from the image. You'll have to find an icon resource. If you decide to use icons that require attribution, make sure to include that in the FOOTER.

The pictures she gave us are huge digital camera photos. Resize them to be more appropriate, and see if you can crop them better since she does not like the middle one being so different. Don't forget the ALT & TITLE attributes on the IMG tags for these.

Ms. Batter's statements like "I don't care about the other colors" and "whatever works best for you" and "use for inspiration" all tell me that she probably wants more changes but doesn't know how to describe them. Get creative and we'll consider a round of revision later.
